## The Death I Want with Dr. Kligler

Monday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> @ 6:00 PM

Dr. Roger Kligler will be lecturing about medical aid in dying (MAiD), the ability of terminally ill, mentally competent individuals to receive a prescription from their physicians to end their suffering by dying in their sleep. Having practiced internal medicine in both inpatient and outpatient setting, he cared for many people during their end of life. He himself has incurable, metastatic prostate cancer and has been treated since 2002. Medical aid in dying is currently authorized in six states and the District of Columbia, with Hawaii starting in 2019. This represents 20% of the US population being covered. He will discuss his personal journey with medicine and as a patient, the 20 years of experience in Oregon with MAiD, and how MAiD improves the end of life care for even those who choose not to use it.

Thursday, July 26<sup>th</sup> @ 7:30 PM

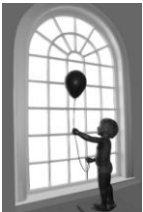
